



## Certain Truth for Uncertain Times, Matthew 6:19-34; 7:24-27

1. Distressing times like these can produce really good fruit amongst God's people. Spend a few moments to see how everyone is doing in this culturally unusual moment.
2. Our 'treasures' can really be revealed during such times can't they? By examining our concerns, fears, anxieties we actually can discern in reverse what our treasures are. Have you been surprised by what you treasure?
3. List two practical expression of love that can show we are seeking God's kingdom first through all of this (Matt 6:33)
4. Talk about practical ways the church (you, not the institution or entity but the people) can be a blessing to others (internally & externally)
  - a. Are there people you should call, text, email, IM to check in on them? Who? What should you say?
  - b. Are there needs you are aware of that you can meet?
  - c. Are the people in our church you know that could be blessed by joining your CG during this time?
  - d. Three times in our text Jesus says do not be anxious (v.25, 31, 34)- we do not need to fear or be afraid as we learned last week, you are apart of the household of God, the people of the living God, a pillar & buttress of truth (1 Tim 3:14-16). Talk about ways you can manifest that reality in this situation.
